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## Grant award of nearly \$250k to Connect Walk-In Clinic Patients with Comprehensive Primary Care

This funding opportunity enables Dorchester House to provide primary care to more patients. Many of whom are newly insured and able to access primary care for the first time. The urgent care facility delivers same day, general primary medical for non-emergent issues for patients and community residents.

Dorchester House Chief Medical Officer Julita Mir explains, "We are integrating a patient centered approach to our urgent care services in order achieve better care for our patients, improved health outcomes for our community and reduce the costs of healthcare."

"We are working to reduce the amount of repeat urgent care visitors by establishing the connection between patient education and preventative treatment." said adult medicine physician, Dr. Kate Harris.

Over the past year 65% of new adult patients have come as a result of their visit to the urgent care services clinic. Under this project, Dorchester House expects to see 600 new patients by the end of the project period in December 2016.
